**Affiliation** with SF-CESS allows schools, organizations, and individuals to formally identify their commitment to CES' 10 Common Principles and specifically to learning about and implementing the conditions necessary for to create and sustain the successful and equitable, small schools our students need.

Affiliation with SF-CESS is informed by two factors:

- 1 The level to which a school's or organization's mission and vision align with and are supported by the mission and vision of SF-CESS.
- 2 The menu of services from SF-CESS a school or organization desires or needs.

### **Benefits of SF-CESS School Affiliation Include:**

- ❑ Connection with a powerful local and national school reform movement.
- ❑ School profile and links on SF-CESS and CES Web sites.
- ❑ Automatic affiliation with CES National
- ❑ Opportunities for individual and community recognition (locally and nationally) through SF-CESS and CES publications including *Horace*, the CES quarterly journal.
- ❑ Free and discounted participation in SF-CESS sponsored networking activities (e.g. networking meetings, networking dinners.)
- ❑ Free and discounted registration for SF-CESS sponsored *community* and *network* Professional Development (e.g. Summer Session, workshops, inquiry groups, workshops, job-alike support groups such as Principals' Groups).
- ❑ Focused Critical Friendship and collaboration through Affiliate School Visits.
